The Career Transition Partnership

CTP support is provided to all Service leavers, regardless of rank, time served or reason for leaving, from two years prior to discharge, and up until two years after discharge. Resettlement support covers three broad areas: Transition, Training and Employment. The CTP support can help Service leavers not just with their first civilian job, but throughout their working lifetime. Additionally, specialist support is provided to Wounded, Injured and Sick personnel via CTP Assist, and to Early Service Leavers via CTP Future Horizons. CTP RightJob lists thousands of live vacancies for Service leavers from local, national and international employers, with opportunities ranging from apprenticeship to executive. Available to those signed up to the scheme. Provides a single up-front payment in 3 separate financial years for higher level learning. Can be claimed up to 10 years after discharge. Covers 80% of fees up to £1000 (4 years' service) or £2000 (8 years' service).
